DOM NOTES!!!.

We have just returned from attending the Southern Baptist Convention meeting in New Orleans June 18-19. We were privileged to be present on the historic election of the first black president of the SBC, Dr. Fred Luter. Dr. Luter is an extremely fine person and dedicated Christian who grew up on the streets of New Orlean. He began his ministry by preaching on street corners in the ninth ward where he later planted a church . That church now has around 9.000 members and is doing a wonderful work in reaching New Orleans for Christ. If you could meet Dr. Luter, hear him preach, and feel his heart, you would have no doubts about why he was elected to this position.

There were several items that were presented to messengers which prompted a lot of debate. One was a motion to change our name from Southern Baptists to Great Commission Baptists. That passed with a 52% or so vote. Another item was a resolution to encourage all of us to use the "sinner's prayer" and "accept Jesus into your heart" as ways to bring people to faith in Christ. That resolution passed also. That item was prompted by a sermon by David Platt urging people not to make the "sinners prayer" a magic formula for asking God to save. Still another resolution was amended to attempt to include a "six-day creation" into the wording that was intended to urge Southern Baptist to take the bible literally and seriously. That amendment failed.

Resolutions passed at the Southern Baptist Convention have no binding effect on any local church They are just a thermometer that tells what that group of messengers believed about an issue at that particular time in history. As we all know, every church in the SBC is autonomous and can vote to do whatever it pleases about any issue. Our guide, of course, is the Bible, God's Holy Word. We are bound to obey every word of that.

We will soon be going to West Virginia on our summer mission trip with about 53 people. We need all the people in WCBA to be praying for us about that. There are so many areas of this endeavor where the Devil can sneak in and get us side-tracked that we must be aware of the need to pray earnestly and fervently every day. The dates of the trip are July 7-13, 2012. Will you, right now, mark these dates on your prayer calendar and lift up this ministry. We will have an 11 man team doing construction, six people cooking for us, and 38 others who will be doing VBS each day. This is no small undertaking and anyone would be foolish, indeed, to attempt it without being sure that God is with us in it all!

Tuesday, August 14, 2012 the annual Sunday School University will be held at the FBC, Martin 6:30 - 9:00 P.M. This is a calendar change that listed the event to be held at Paris. Please get the word to all of your Sunday School faculty and teachers about this meeting. There will be an excellent experienced faculty to lead each session. There are lots of class options for every age group with practical content to help you reach, teach, and minister through your own Sunday School. There will be some special emphases in the conference on helping to impact lostness in Tennessee. If you are concerned about the future of your church, then you should plan to take advantage of this opportunity sponsored by the Tennessee Baptist Convention.
